The **EA SPORTS BC Soccer Premier League** is pleased to confirm the schedule for the 4th annual **BCSPL UNIVERSITY SHOWCASE**, presented by **Canada's College ID Camp**, on the May 24-26 weekend. The event will be hosted by **Thompson Okanagan FC**.

BCSPL U16 and U17 boys and girls teams will play games at McArthur Island in Kamloops, providing opportunities for coaches to identify players in a centralized location. The BCSPL has invited back our tier 1 neighbours from Alberta to participate with 5 girls teams who have confirmed their attendance, along with 2 Nova Scotia provincial boys teams and 30 BCSPL teams in total. The players are from the 2003 and 2002 age groups.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR TEAMS

ALL player profile rosters should be in on or before May 20 in time to be included in the profile book for all university coaches.

There will be a main information tent on site for all teams at McArthur Island, and all teams should check in 45 minutes prior to their first game.

There will also be a couple athletic trainers in central locations during all games. While they won't be at each field to come on the field, they can be summoned if required to team benches or players can find their central tent area. They can tape ankles and will deal with injuries, but any players needing ankles taped should bring their own rolls of tape.

There will be ice with the trainers on site, but those are specifically for treating injuries. All teams should bring their own water and ice if required for their general team use, as none will be provided at the benches.

The BC SPL will schedule all officials, and they are being paid directly by BC Soccer. Non-BC teams should pay their invoice prior to their first game by cheque to the league's headquarter tent. BC SPL clubs will be invoiced at the conclusion of phase 1 for these fees along with all phase 1 referee fees.

Games durations:

All BC SPL vs BC SPL league games will follow standard BC SPL league rules.

All games involving non-BC teams will be 2x45 minute halves. Games can end in a tie, and no extra time will be played. The half time break will be 10 minutes.

As the game times are scheduled back to back, please clear your bench and exit the field of play right after the game so the next teams can start play ASAP. All post game team talks or cool downs need to be done away from the field so the next game can start.

Substitutions for BCSPL league games are the same as BCSPL rules.

Substitutions for non-league games are unlimited at any time with re-entry allowed in the same half.

Substitution slips are only required for official BCSPL league games.

While this is only considered an exhibition weekend between BCSPL and non-BC teams, the non-BC teams should all obtain travel approval from their provincial association. Only registered players are allowed to participate.

Home teams on the schedule should provide the two game balls to the officials.

Game roster sheets are ONLY required for BCSPL league games, and both teams should print and bring 2 copies from the website as usual.

For all non-league games, no game rosters are required (referees will be referring to your profile roster forms in case of issues). Officials will have their own reporting form for all non-league games.

There will be no anthems or announcements for any game, however all teams will undertake a brief international style walkout with pre-game handshakes. Post game handshakes should take place quickly so the next game can proceed.

All teams should have two jersey colours available. In the event of a colour conflict, the AWAY team on the schedule will be responsible for changing colours.
